1. Verses 1-2: God is in control!
2. Verses 3-11: Judas's heart revealed
 - a. Either you come to Jesus like the woman and look for what you can _____ in return, or you come to Jesus like Judas and look for what you can _____ in return!
3. Verses 12-17: Passover prepared
4. Verses 18-25: Passover explained
 - a. It's all about fellowship here! Broken fellowship of Judas versus the ultimate perfected fellowship with God!

**This is the story of Judas- I am Judas! I need a Savior!*

5. Verses 26-31: The Only One who is able
 - a. Peter in his pride thinks of himself as perfectly able!

**This is the story of Peter- I am Peter! I need a Savior and Lord!*

6. Verses 32-42: The Garden
 - a. Jesus
 - i. Notice what word isn't in the list: _____
 - ii. Jesus was horrified thinking about taking the wrath of God which meant He needed to be separated from His Father.
 - iii. Yet He set aside the immediate desire for the ultimate desire!
 - b. Disciples
 - i. “The remarkable element in the scene is that in the midst of unparalleled agony Jesus twice more came to look after His three vulnerable disciples and to warn them of their danger of failure in the struggle which was about to overwhelm them.”- William Lane
7. Verses 43-52: Two Kingdoms
 - a. He was ushering in a revolution, but it wasn't about violence and power. His Kingdom is about Him “getting what we deserve so that we can get what He deserves”.- Timothy Keller

8. Verses 50-52: They all left Him and fled!

PASSOVER MEAL

*Begun with prayer by the head of the family then recitation of Psalms 113-118

#1 Cup of Wine: Cup of Salvation

“I will bring you out...”- God promised to save His people from the Egyptians. Exodus 3:19-20

Worship through Psalm 113-115

#2 Cup of Wine: Cup of Judgement

“I will deliver you from slavery to them...”- Many people lost their lives in order to accomplish the salvation. Exodus 12:12

Meal eaten: first the bread, broke into pieces and passed, then the lamb and greens

#3 Cup of Wine: Cup of Redemption

“I will redeem you...”- God used the blood of a lamb to save His people that night. Exodus 12:13

Worship through Psalm 116-118

#4 Cup of Wine: Cup of Restoration

“I will take you to be My people, and I will be your God...”- God will restore His people to Himself
